Academic Focus

This 8-week internship program, offered through The Education Abroad Network (TEAN), is designed to provide students with the opportunity to gain practical work experience in a responsible position in a business or government agency in Western Australia. Interns are provided with meaningful work assignments and assigned research projects related to their work experience. Opportunities are developed in consultation with the course instructor and department chair and require approval of both.

Course Expectations

Students are expected to attend pre-departure orientation. TEAN staff will conduct pre-departure advising sessions before, during, and after program enrollment. It is expected that all students participate in the 3-Day Orientation in Australia.

Accommodations

Lodging: TEAN guarantees prearranged, fully-furnished, comfortable housing options in convenient locations - on and off campus. Housing costs are comparable to other programs, but receive many additional features, like landline phone service and internet connections. Housing costs are *not* included in the overall fee.

Meals: Housing comes with kitchens, where the student can prepare their own meals. During the 3-Day Orientation, some meals are included. There is also a Welcome and Farewell dinner included in the program cost.

Eligibility Requirements

- Open to all majors with a junior/senior standing. If approved, the second internship is applied as an elective
- Minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA
- Availability of academic credits to fulfill degree requirements
- Good disciplinary, financial and academic standing
- Participation in mandatory pre-departure orientation on Saturday, April 12, 2014 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Complete online application and submit all required supplemental materials to the Office of International Programs by the application deadline. Applications will not be reviewed until all application materials are received.
