Non-Denominational Wedding Policy

Non-denominational weddings may be held in the great hall of Ochre Court provided the date is available. Weddings are only scheduled when students are not on campus – Memorial Day through the weekend prior to Labor Day weekend, holiday weekends and academic breaks.

Non-denominational weddings are scheduled by Johanna Mancivalano, director of conferences and events. Please contact Johanna at (401) 341-2460 or johanna.mancivalano@salve.edu and be prepared to give two or three dates of interest so that she may check availability.

The University will provide and set up a maximum of 200 chairs and any tables required. The bride and groom are responsible for arranging for an individual to officiate (cannot be a Catholic priest), photographer, florist and musicians for the ceremony.

Non-Refundable Fees

- Salve Regina graduates, current students, faculty and staff may use Ochre Court for a fee of \$700.
- The fee for those with no affiliation to the University is \$3,000.
- The fee includes the use of Ochre Court for a total of two hours the day of your wedding, one hour the day prior for the rehearsal, setup and breakdown of tables and chairs, and staff support leading up to and at the rehearsal and ceremony.
