

Registration Guidelines for Pell Honors Program Fall 2018

The Pell Honors Program is open to students from any academic discipline. Pell students are required to take a Pell course from of the following two disciplines during their freshman year:

- History
- Social Science (Economics, Political Science, or Sociology & Anthropology)

Pell sections carry the letter P in the course code (i.e., UNV-101-P2 or HIS-114-P1).

First-year students are advised to **register for the following:**

- **Pell section of UNV101**, University Seminar I (3 credits) and **FYT100**, First Year Seminar (1 credit)
(You will be automatically registered for FYT-100 because it is linked to your UNV-101 choice)
- **One Pell section of a core courses** (3 credits):
 - **HIS113**, History of the United States to 1877
 - **ECN101**, Introductory Macroeconomics
 - **POL115**, The American Political System
 - **POL120**, How to Rule the World
 - **SOA249**, Global Health (recommended for Nursing majors)
