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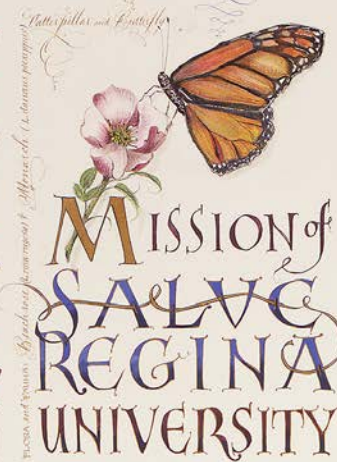
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SALVE REGINA UNIVERSITY MISSION

Download the App

Search for Corq on the App Store or Play Store and download!



2

Search "Salve Regina"

Select Salve Regina University as your campus and it will direct you to all our campus events.



3

Log In

On the top left corner, sign in with your Salve credentials (salve email without "@salve.edu".) You can then see all the events you have chosen to attend.



4

Download your Event Pass

On the top left corner, click "Event Pass." Add it to your wallet to make future event check-in's easy!

RSVP For Events

Click on any event you plan on attending as some programming has capacity limits. You will then see these events in your "My Events" tab.
