Joint Bachelor's/Master's Degree Programs

Salve offers qualified undergraduate students an accelerated program that leads to both a bachelor's and a master's degree. This program is for undergraduate students with a grade point average of 3.30 or higher. **Current undergraduates must complete the application process by February 15 of their junior year.**

Undergraduate students considered for the program are conditionally accepted and must take four graduate courses (12 credits) their senior year. Of these 12 credits, six are applied to the undergraduate degree. Final master's program acceptance is contingent upon successful completion of the undergraduate degree and the four graduate courses in the senior year. Student's interested in the joint bachelor's and master's degree in either holistic or rehabilitation programs will need additional time and requirements to complete the 48 credit degree.

Applicants are strongly encouraged to contact the program director.

Application Requirements

To apply to this program, students must submit the following materials to the Office of Graduate Admissions:

- Completed online application at admissions.salve.edu/apply
- Personal statement: Essay of 1-2 pages discussing your interest in pursuing a graduate degree program.
- Two letters of recommendation
- Resume

The deadline to apply is February 15 of the student's junior year.
