

## Directions

GPS directions to the Casino Theatre from your location are [available here](#).

### From Boston Area

- Take MA-24 South
- Exit onto I-195 W/MA-24 S toward Fall River
- Take exit 14A toward Tiverton/Newport
- Continue onto RI-24 S
- Turn left at light onto Valley Road (at Town Fair Tire)
- Continue onto Aquidneck Avenue
- Turn left onto Freebody Street, the Casino Theatre will be on your right

### From Providence Area

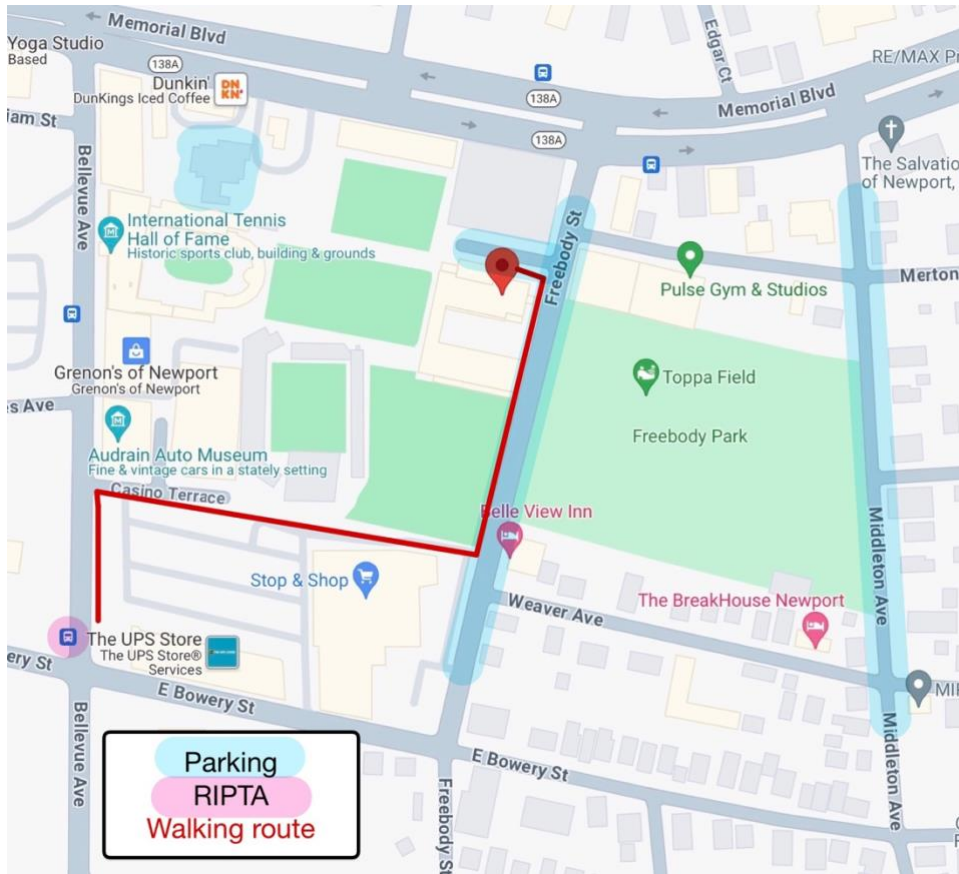
- Take I-195 South
- Continue onto RI-4 S, following signs to North Kingstown
- Take Jamestown and Pell (Newport) Bridges
- Turn left onto ramp to RI-238 N, then turn left again onto RI-238 N
- Turn right onto America's Cup Avenue, and continue onto Memorial Boulevard
- Turn right onto Freebody Street, the Casino Theatre will be on your right

### From NYC Area

- Take I-195 N
- Take exit 14A toward North Kingstown
- Use ramp to Narragansett to merge onto RI-4 S, and continue onto US-1
- Take Jamestown and Pell (Newport) Bridges
- Turn left onto ramp to RI-238 N, then turn left again onto RI-238 N
- Turn right onto America's Cup Avenue, and continue onto Memorial Boulevard
- Turn right onto Freebody Street, the Casino Theatre will be on your right

## Parking

The Casino Theatre has a 10-spot lot attached, including one handicap accessible spot, that is shared with the Tennis Hall of Fame. Free street parking is available on Freebody Street and Middleton Avenue.



## Public Transit

To avoid limited parking, visitors may take the RIPTA 67 to Bellevue Plaza and cut through the parking lot to Freebody Street, then take a left to the Casino Theatre.

## Restaurants

The surrounding Bellevue Avenue and Memorial Boulevard are home to many of Newport's popular restaurants, including Pasta Beach, Mr. R, Mori Sushi, Cru Cafe and La Forge Casino Restaurant.
