

Harassment and Discrimination Courses:

The online training courses can be accessed by visiting the United Educators training platform learn.ue.org/login2.aspx. All employees have been pre-registered for applicable courses. Please log in using your Salve Regina email address and either the password you were originally provided or if you've already accessed the system, the unique password you created. If you do not have a computer to use at your workstation, please consult with your supervisor to determine where you may take the training on campus.

Employees hired in 2019 who have previously completed all required trainings will not be required to complete the trainings. Reports will be sent periodically to all supervisors and/or chairs with completion/non-completion information for each of their respective employees.

All supervisors/chairs will be required to take the following courses:

- Prevent Discrimination and Harassment Together – Supervisors
- Prevent Sexual Violence Together
- Avoiding Supervisory Pitfalls

All other staff and faculty will be required to take the following courses:

- Prevent Discrimination and Harassment Together
- Prevent Sexual Violence Together
