

Research options and internships are available in every academic program. You can also earn a master's degree in **international relations, data science** or **MBA** with just one additional year or **engineering** through our 3+3 partnership with Washington University in St. Louis.

SALVE C&MPASS

salve.edu/compass

Connect college-to-career through the **Salve Compass** program, a series of co-curricular experiences over four years that complement your University courses to build leadership skills and resiliency.

Start with yearlong advising and mid-year retreat in year one followed by a summer project in beautiful Newport in year two and experiential learning off campus in year three. In the fourth year, integrate what you learn in a culminating project with your favorite professor.

COST AND FINANCIAL AID

Tuition, fees, housing and food for 2023-2024 total \$65,430.

Students are automatically considered for **merit scholarships** based on the documents they submit for admission. Awards range between \$15,000 and \$32,500 with a limited number of scholarships covering full tuition.

Need-based financial aid is only available to U.S. citizens and permanent residents, and requires the filing of the FAFSA form.

ADMISSIONS

Salve is a member of the Common Application and we review everything that we ask students to submit. SAT/ACT tests are optional but the following items are required to complete an application:

- Official school transcripts
- Two letters of recommendation
- Applicable national exam results, certificates or diplomas
- Evidence of English proficiency for non-native speakers (TOEFL, IELTS or Duolingo tests, see *salve.edu/english-proficiency*)
- Portfolio required for studio art
- Audition required for dance

Application Deadlines

September Admission

- November 1: Early Action I, Early Decision, and nursing candidates
- January 5: Early Action II
- February 1: Regular Decision

January Admission

• December 1

Applications are welcome after each deadline and reviewed on a rolling, space-available basis.
