# Salve Regina University Pathways Program Scholars 2022-23 APPLICATION & INFORMATION

### **Horizon Scholars**

Horizon Scholars is a multi-year, intensive precollege program for students from Rogers High School Through mentorship from Salve Regina faculty, Staff and students, participants develop the confidence and skills to be well-prepared college applicants, successful college students, and professionals who create positive, lasting change.

### Summer Program

Students admitted to the Horizon Scholars program begin by attending the Summer Program which provides the opportunity to experience what it is like to study at a private, liberal arts college.

The 2023 Summer Program will be held in June 2023 – Dates to be announced

### Year-Round Activities

Following the Summer Program, Horizon Scholars receive academic resources and mentorship throughout high school. Students attend weekend events on the Salve Regina campus including book clubs, science research opportunities, ACT preparation classes, workshops and fieldtrips. As seniors, Horizon Scholars receive personalized assistance in the college application process. Transportation assistance is provided.

### Cost

There is no cost for participation in the Pathways Program; Salve Regina and program sponsors cover all expenses.

### Eligibility

Students are *eligible* to be considered for the Horizon Scholars program if they meet ONE or more of the following criteria:

- Qualify for free or reduced-price lunch, or otherwise demonstrate financial need
- Will be the first generation in their family to attend college required
- Is on the honor roll
- Is proficient in RICAS

Selection Criteria Applicants should be highly-motivated students seeking a challenging and fun academic experience. Evaluation of applicants is based on:

- Academic performance: While there is no minimum GPA requirement, the selection committee seeks students with grades of A and/or B in core subjects
- Short Answers: Applicants must demonstrate strong writing and critical thinking skills
- Recommendation(s)
- Extracurricular activities and community engagement
- Demonstrated commitment to completing the multi-year Horizon Scholars program as outlined in the application

The Pathways Program is committed to helping students achieve their academic goals. In order to best serve our students, we have developed a challenging and interactive program that requires full participation and commitment from all participants. Please read the program description carefully and understand that all Horizon Scholars are expected to follow through with all components of the program.

#### Summer Program

If admitted to the Horizon Scholars Program, I (student) understand that I will attend the program in **June 2023**. I understand that students are required to participate in planned workshops, lectures and other planned activities for the full duration of the program. Further, I understand that it is my responsibility to make arrangements with my school in anticipation of any absences that may result from my participation.

### **Year-Round Activities**

If admitted to the Horizon Scholars Program, I (student) commit to actively participating in the Horizon Scholars Program year-round throughout high school. Example activities and events include, fieldtrips to museums and college fairs, writing workshops, and special events on the Salve Regina campus. Gradespecific requirements for each year of participation in the program are stated below. I understand that most of these events will occur on weekends. Transportation assistance is provided.

### 10<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Required participation in weekly academic enrichments and activities
- Required participation in two (2) Extracurricular Events per semester between August and June of sophomore year.

### 11<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Required participation in weekly academic enrichments and activities
- Required participation in two (2) Extracurricular Events per semester between August and June of junior year.
- Required participation in an **SAT/ACT** prep course.

### 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Participation in Extracurricular Events is strongly encouraged, but not required.
- Required participation in **Senior College Application Workshop Series** which take place once a month during the fall semester of senior year.
- Required participation in **Financial Aid Workshop Series which** includes two (2) workshops during the fall semester and one (1) during early spring semester of senior year.
- Participation in Senior Celebration Ceremony held in the month of May.

### Academic Performance in School

If admitted to the Horizon Scholars Program, I (student) understand that I will be expected to maintain a minimum 2.7 GPA (unweighted) each semester. I will notify Pathways staff any time I anticipate earning a grade lower than a B- or am finding a class to be especially challenging. I further understand that I am expected to send a copy of my report card or transcript to Pathways staff at the end of each semester.

### **Application Deadline**

If mailing, applications for the 2023 Horizon Scholars cohort must be **postmarked** no later than **Wednesday**, **March 1**, 2023. Mail all forms, in one envelope, directly to the address noted below. Or return to Rogers High School. Please keep a copy of all documents for your records. We will confirm receipt of applications via email. <u>Late or incomplete applications</u> <u>will not be considered</u>.
