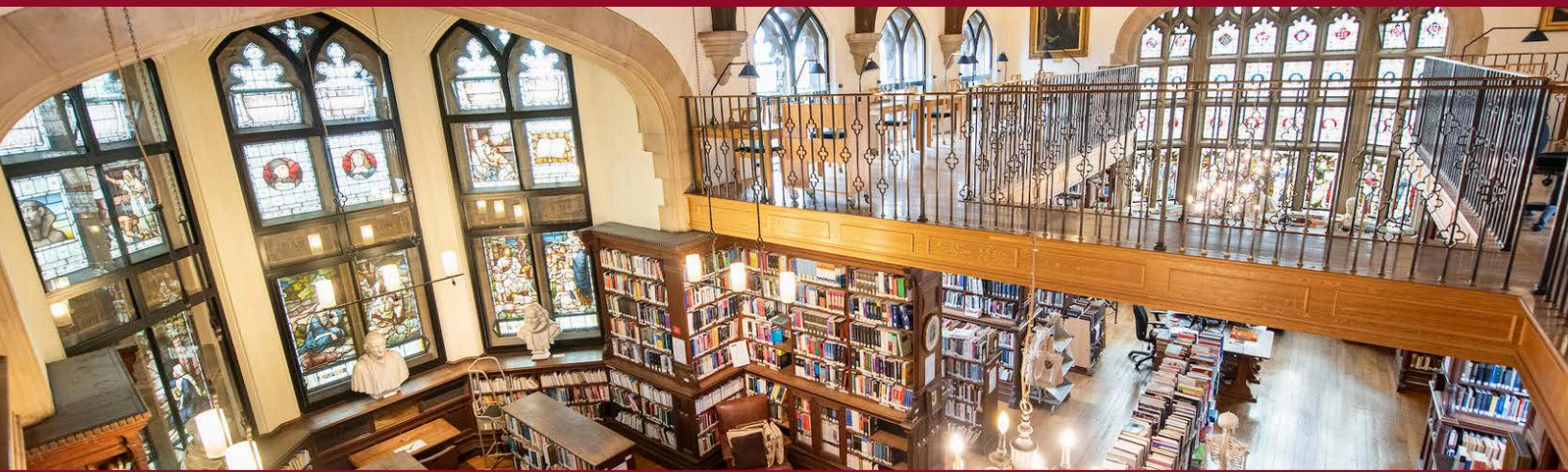

During this 3- week intensive political economy program, Salve Regina students, with Dr. Adam Witham, will accompany Hampden-Sydney College students and faculty to Harris Manchester College at the University of Oxford. Studying in Oxford will allow students to learn the theory, history, and application of political economy in an experiential setting. The program will include a weekend trip to London as well as excursions to various sites in Oxford.

Academics

6-credit program with courses taught by Salve Regina and Hampden-Sydney Faculty

Students select two courses from these options:

- 1. Comparative Political Economy** - Taught by Dr. Dempster
 - Salve equivalent: ECN 420 - fulfills requirement in Economics BA, elective in Economics BS, and elective in Economics minor
- 2. Topics in Political Economy** - Taught by Dr. Witham
 - Salve equivalent: ECN 399 Special Topics - fulfills Economics elective in major and minor
- 3. International Trade** - Taught by Dr. Isaacs
 - Salve equivalent: ECN 411 - fulfills elective in Economics major and minor

Final coursework will be due by August 15, 2025. All course fulfillments subject to approval by an advisor.

Eligibility Requirements

- Economics 101 or equivalent is a pre-requisite for all courses
- 2.7 or higher GPA
- Students from Political Science, Economics, Business, & Philosophy departments are encouraged to apply

How to Apply:

1. Complete an online application for Salve Regina and submit all required materials on the [ViaTRM](#) portal by **December 1, 2024**. Application will open by October 1. Materials include:
 - 250 word essay on your study abroad goals
 - Faculty reference
 - Photo of passport or self-disclosure of passport application
 - Headshot
2. Complete a secondary online application and deposit for Hampden-Sydney College by **February 1, 2025**
 - Instructions for completing Hampden-Sydney College application will be in the acceptance letter email from Salve Regina.

Academic Focus

Students will be able to compare and contrast cross-national similarities and differences of political economy in an experiential setting. Assignments will be crafted to utilize the rich cultural and social landscape, as well as visit the international institutions and global enterprises unique to Oxford and London. Courses will discuss the origins and development of political economy, how economics impacts various public policy issues, and trade policies and patterns in different types of markets and nations.

Course Expectations

A mandatory pre-departure meeting will be held in the spring to inform students of program content and requirements. Expect a rewarding curriculum that includes classroom lectures and local excursions. You'll be expected to actively participate in all activities, complete assignments on time, and engage respectfully with a new culture as well as new students and faculty from Hampden-Sydney College.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Open to all students (first year through senior)
- Min GPA 2.7
- Availability of academic credits to fulfill degree requirements
- Good disciplinary, financial and academic standing
- Participation in mandatory pre-departure orientation
