During this 4-week program, Salve Regina students will be hosted by St. Clare's, Oxford, an international college, where they can earn up to 6 credits in English, Business, Art, or Religion. The program includes exciting excursions to London and Bath, featuring a play at Shakespeare's Globe Theatre. View the Magna Carta at Salisbury Cathedral, explore the grounds of Blenheim Palace, get as close as you can to Hogwarts by checking out its model, Christ Church College, visit Stonehenge, the Roman Baths, the British Museum, the Royal Courts of Justice, and more!

## Academics

6-credit program with courses taught by Salve and local St. Clare's faculty.

Students select two, 3-credit courses from these options:

**1. Literature of Place** – Taught by Dr. Sally Gomaa

- Fulfills Literature core req., Pell Special Topics, or English major/minor req.

**2. European Financial Markets & Currency** – Taught by Prof. Sam Sacco

- Can be used to fulfill one of the following requirements: MGT270 Financial Management, elective in Business Admin. or Finance majors, PELL 299/Special Topics Requirement, elective in Economics minor/major (group 5 elective), elective requirement in 5 year MBA with approval, free elective.

**3. Eastern Religions**

- Fulfills Religion core req. or RTS major/minor req.

**4. Shakespeare**

- Fulfills Literature core req. or English major/minor req.

**5. Oxford Art & Architecture**

- Fulfills Visual & Performing Arts core req. or CHP elective

*All course fulfillments are subject to approval by an advisor.*

## Eligibility Requirements

- Open to first year through senior year students, or 5th year MBA students.
- Good disciplinary, financial and academic standing at the time of program departure.
- 2.7 or higher GPA

## How to Apply

Complete an online application and submit all required materials on the [ViaTRM](#) portal by the program deadline. Application will open by October 1.

Materials include:

- 250 word essay on your study abroad goals
- Faculty reference
- Photo of passport or self-disclosure of passport application
- Headshot

## Academic Focus

The program emphasizes experiential learning, with frequent trips to Oxford sites that feature in the readings such as Alice in Wonderland's Port Meadow, Jane Austen's Bath, Christ Church College (the model for Harry Potter's Hogwarts) and the famous Eagle and Child pub, where C.S. Lewis, J. R. R. Tolkien and their writing club, the Inklings, met to discuss literature and share their latest creative works. Ranging beyond Oxford, students will travel to London and Bath and will take in a play at an exact replica of the Globe Theater, experiencing drama as it was enjoyed in Shakespeare's day.

## Course Expectations

A mandatory pre-departure meeting will be held in the spring to inform students of program content and requirements. Expect a rewarding curriculum that includes classroom lectures and local excursions. You'll be expected to actively participate in all activities, complete assignments on time, and engage respectfully with a new culture.

- Open to all students (first year through senior)
- Min GPA 2.7
- Availability of academic credits to fulfill degree requirements
- Good disciplinary, financial and academic standing
- Participation in mandatory pre-departure orientation
