Program Requirements

You will earn your MSN-FNP by completing 48 credits and a minimum of 750 hours of precepted clinical work (split across three courses). A minimum of 39* credits must be taken at Salve Regina University to obtain your master's degree. To apply, you must have an RN license that is current and in good standing, and you must have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher. All qualified students are eligible for admission regardless of race, color, age, gender, disability, religion or national origin.

**students can only transfer a maximum of 9 credits*
