

PARKING REGULATIONS 2026-2027

The University assumes no responsibility for the loss or theft of, damage to, or property missing from vehicles parked or operated on the Salve Regina University campus.

All faculty, staff, students and visitors operating or parking a vehicle on campus are responsible for familiarizing themselves with and understanding these regulations and to have their vehicles registered with the Department of Public Safety.

The Office of Public Safety (OPS) is the only office that may authorize an exception to the parking policy. If an exception is granted, the student is responsible to get the name and badge number of the officer granting permission.

Resident and Commuter Students:

The City of Newport restricts parking on the following streets between the hours of midnight and 6:00 a.m.

Ward Avenue

Lawrence Avenue (between Webster and Leroy)

Narragansett Avenue

Webster Street Victoria Avenue

Wetmore Avenue

Students parked at these locations are subject to policy violations issued by Salve Regina DPS in addition to parking tickets by the Newport Police.

A. Registration of Motor Vehicles

All applicants for a campus vehicle permit must register via the On-line vehicle registration portal (via MySalve)

Once a vehicle has been registered, campus permit will be available for pick up within 24 hours at the OPS, a valid University I.D. Card, driver's license, state registration certificate, and proof of insurance will be required to pick up any parking permit.

- A fee of one hundred dollars per academic year will be assessed for undergraduate parking permits.

- A fee of one hundred dollars per academic year will be assessed for graduate parking permits.
- A fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) will be assessed for replacement parking permits

Parking in all lots and streets adjacent to the University require a valid parking permit.

If you are having a guest visit with a vehicle you must obtain a guest parking pass at the Office of Public Safety. Guest parking passes will only be granted for parking in SRU lots from Fridays at 5:00pm until Sundays at 5:00pm. Fraudulent presentation of documentation to obtain a guest parking pass will result in suspension of privileges for all SRU parties involved and referred to the Dean of Students Office for further review.

Issued permits must be affixed to the outside of the rear driver's side window (lower left corner). Permits are not transferable. Improper use or display of a permit will be treated as a violation under these regulations. Any alteration to permit, including lamination is against regulations and will be treated as violation.

All resident students must register their vehicle.

Permits are not refundable or transferable.

The OPS must be notified immediately of any change of vehicle, state registration plate or other information pertinent to motor vehicle registration.

Fraudulent presentation of documentation to obtain a parking permit will result in suspension of privileges for all parties involved.

B. One Car/One Space Policy (Resident Policy)

Upperclassman resident students are assigned parking in an authorized parking area on campus. Resident student vehicles may not be used for any reason for on-campus transportation Monday-Friday 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. This includes all campus parking lots (other than the one your

vehicle is assigned) and Newport city streets adjacent to the University. (see University Student Handbook for more information: salve.edu/document/student-handbook)

C. Motorcycles and Mopeds

Motorcycles, mopeds and motor scooters will be subject to the same parking and traffic regulations as other motor vehicles and must be registered with the OPS via the on-line registration system.

All motor driven cycles are prohibited from the interior of any campus building or interior storage areas.

D. Enforcement

OPS personnel are authorized and directed to enforce all motor vehicle, traffic, and parking regulations contained herein and promulgated by the OPS. Failure to comply with the directions of Security personnel acting in the performance of their duties is a serious violation of University regulations. A University Security officer may require an owner, operator or passenger of a motor vehicle to produce proper identification. Refusal to identify oneself is a serious violation of University regulations.

E. Snow Emergencies

The Director of OPS, in coordination with the Superintendent of Grounds, is authorized to restrict parking on campus during a declared snow emergency so that snow removal operations are not impeded. Parking ban information will be broadcast via the University email and University social media sites.

F. Penalties and Fines

Parking privileges may be revoked if you receive five (5) or more parking tickets during an academic year. The student who registers the motor vehicle is ultimately responsible regardless of who was operating the vehicle at the time of the violation.

If vehicle privileges have been revoked the vehicle must promptly be removed from University property and surrounding streets. Loss of privileges also precludes the student who has lost privileges from using a different

vehicle to park on campus or within the City of Newport.

G. Towing

All illegally parked vehicles or vehicles in violation of the University parking policy are subject to towing.

H. Appeals

Commuters and upper-class students charged with a violation have the right to request an appeal of the violation. Tickets issued to freshman resident students, Fire lane and Handicap violations are not subject to appeal. I. Guest Parking and Student Responsibility

If you are having a guest visit with a vehicle you must obtain a guest parking pass at the Office of Public Safety. Guest parking passes will only be granted for parking in SRU lots from Fridays at 5:00pm until Sundays at 5:00pm. Fraudulent presentation of documentation to obtain a guest parking pass will result in suspension of privileges for all SRU parties involved and referred to the Dean of Students Office for further review.

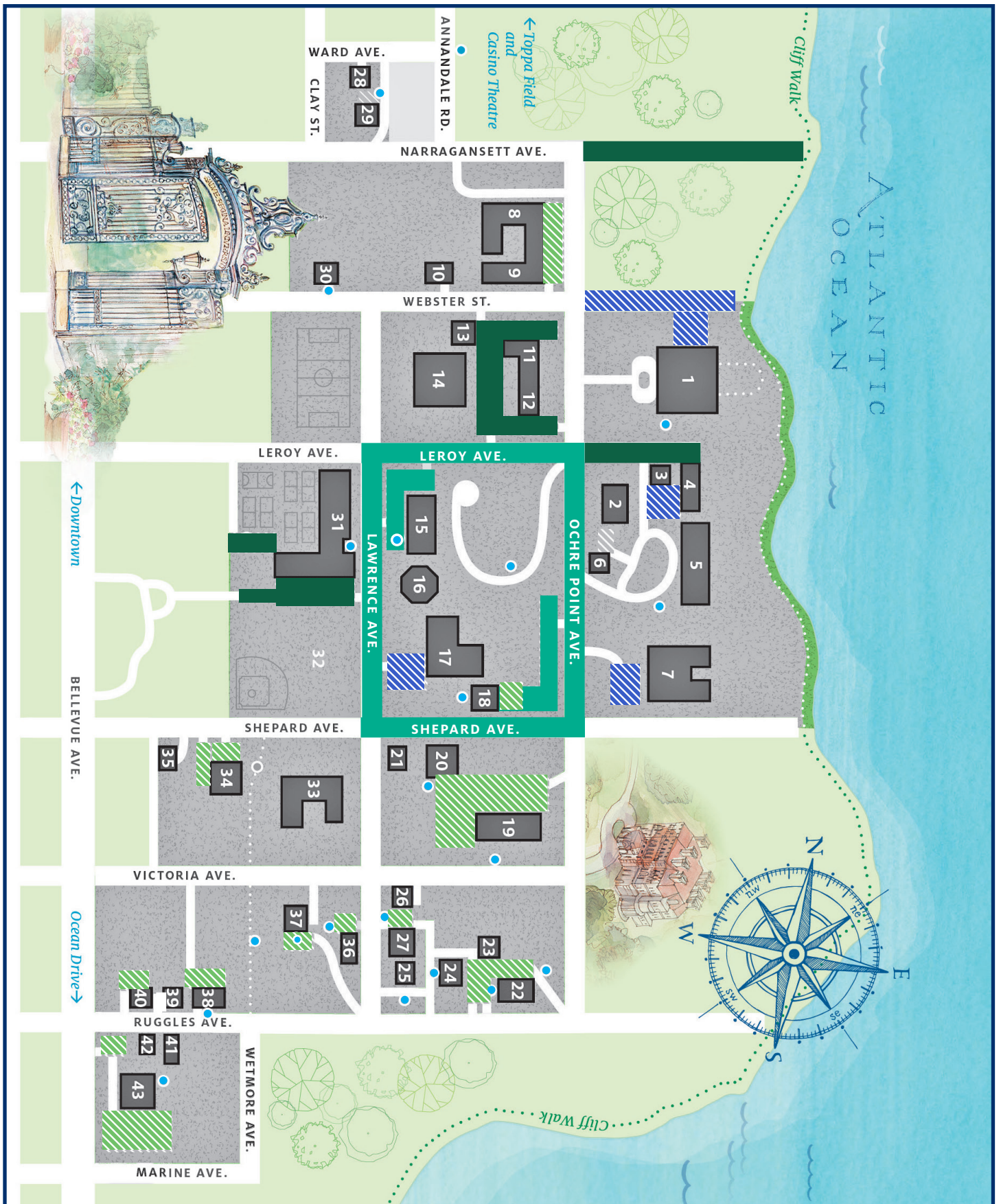
