## What is included on the bill?





- \$300 credit for enrollment fee (remaining \$400 in escrow for housing)
- Activity Fee-\$250 per semester to fund student activities, organizations, events held on campus and access to RIPTA bus service
- Technology fee-\$215 per semester to fund Wi-Fi, computer labs, office 365 usage, etc.
- Meal plan- \$4,090 per semester (if on campus, unlimited for freshmen)
  can select any option with Bursar Office if off-campus
- Traditional Housing (freshmen)- \$5,660 per semester
- Course or lab or program fees
- Insurances (details to follow)
- \$325 New Seahawk Orientation Fee
- \$25,650 Full-time tuition per semester
- Financial aid award (less work-study award)

## Why does the bill include two insurance fees?



**Personal Property Insurance:** Salve Regina offers supplemental personal property insurance through National Student Services. The plan offers varying amounts of coverage and deductibles for an annual premium.

### University Health Plans (**Medical**):

- \$1,995 for year charged in Fall
- Required by state of RI to ensure all full-time undergraduates are insured in a comparable policy
- Option to complete enrollment form for coverage beginning August 15th at https://www.universityhealthplans.com
- Option to waive by August 1<sup>st</sup> at https://www.universityhealthplans.com
- For HIPPA privacy, this is separate from Health Services or Athletics insurance forms

### Dewar (Tuition Protection):

- \$175 per semester for on-campus; \$131 per semester for off-campus
- Salve Regina offers an insurance plan that guarantees a tuition and room and board refund in cases of physical illness (85 percent reimbursement) and/or mental illness (85 percent reimbursement) any time during the semester
- All full-time undergraduate students are automatically enrolled
- Student cannot receive a grade for the term and separate from SRU before finals
- Option to waive at <u>https://www.tuitionprotection.com/salve</u> by August 1st

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# When is payment due?

- August 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall (bills were made available on June 18<sup>th</sup>)
- December 15<sup>th</sup> for Spring (bills available by Thanksgiving break)
- \$400 late fee (per term) if sufficient payment arrangements have not been made
  - Accounts will be sent to collections if remains delinquent or not enrolled in a past due payment plan after six months
- Request for a \$500 returning student deposit sent in April with a May 1<sup>st</sup> due date







### Is there a parent portal?

Students can view all financial transactions online on Nelnet via their Campus@Salve portal

Option to enroll as an Authorized User for parents/guardians/payers

(stop by the Bursar Office or Nelnet Tables @ the Lender Fair for instructions/assistance in enrolling)

## How can I make a payment?

Financial aid-as Brock discussed in his presentation

**Traditional payments-** check or cash in person/mail, electronic funds transfer via Nelnet (no additional fees)

**Monthly payment options-** up to 6 months per term through Salve's partnership with Nelnet – *be sure to stop by their booth @ the fair* 

Online or mailed 529 payment

Alternative (Outside) loan options- be sure to visit with the various Lenders at the Fair

Parent loan options

**Credit card option via Nelnet**- Visa, MasterCard or Discover (note: there is a service fee based on the card type)

**International:** Salve Regina has partnered with Convera GlobalPay and Flywire to offer convenient options for international students to pay tuition and other fees from their home country and in their home currency.

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#### What if I have a credit?

- Refund checks for credit balances not related to financial aid will be issued only if requested through My Salve (E-Refund)
- Delivery methods: EFT (direct deposit) or mailed home to permanent address
- EFTS are processed on Wednesday, paper checks on Fridays
- All aid must be disbursed (will not advance for pending aid) but request can be completed at anytime
- Any Title IV credit will be automatically refunded within 14 calendar days

### What can the Salve Card do for YOU?

#### • Watch our video streaming in the cafeteria!

- The Salve Card can be utilized for on-campus purchases in the Miley dining hall, McKillop Library Cafe, Jazzman's Cafe, Sandella's Cafe, Miley Mart/Starbucks, the Nest and the Salve Regina bookstore.
- Deposits can be made online with Mastercard or Visa, in person at the Business Office with cash or check, or by mail with a check.
- Once money has been added, it cannot be removed. Balance over \$5 will be refunded back once the student leaves the University
- Seahawk bucks are tied to the meal plan
- Students can exceed the printing credit (\$20 per semester)
  - Overage will be charged to the bill



## **Withdrawal Policies and Refunds:**





BE SURE TO REVIEW THE REFUND SCHEDULE AT HTTPS://SALVE.EDU/BUSINESS-OFFICE/WITHDRAWAL-POLICIES-AND-REFUNDS BEFORE MAKING A FINAL DECISION STUDENT WILL NOT BE CHARGED IF HE/SHE LEAVES BEFORE THE START OF THE SEMESTER AND COMPLETES ALL WITHDRAWAL PAPERWORK AND SUBMITS TO THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE

REFUNDS ARE PROCESSED WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE UNIVERSITY HAS RECEIVED OFFICIAL NOTIFICATION OF THE WITHDRAWAL
