Pre-Law Track



There is no single major that you should pursue to prepare for law school. Instead, you should balance your education with rigorous coursework in disciplines outside of your chosen major. This approach builds a solid foundation of skills that is sought after by admissions committees and prepares you for the demands of law school.

We offer two courses on advanced topics in law, which cover multiple areas that you will explore in your first two years of law school. You have additional opportunities to deepen your knowledge in the liberal arts and sciences through our Core Curriculum. This framework allows you to choose courses that develop comprehensive reading, writing and analytical reasoning skills, extensive oral communication and listening skills, and critical time management skills that will lead to success in law school and in your career.

For admission, law schools emphasize the Law School Admission Test (LSAT) and the cumulative GPA, as well as extracurricular and community involvements. We offer extensive internship, experiential learning and service opportunities, and many professors collaborate with students to conduct in-depth research that often leads to conference presentations and publications.

Pre-Law Advising

Our pre-law advisor assists with the application process and provides guidance on courses, internships and research that will enhance students' applications. We also host events for current students to meet with alumni and learn about their experiences applying to and attending law school.

After extensive preparation, you should aim to take the LSAT during the summer after your junior year or the fall of your senior year.
