Includes students that earned their degree in May 2018 (August and December graduates were not surveyed.)</p> <p><b>CALCULATION:</b> Number of students in graduate school is divided by the total number of students for which information was gathered.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Information was gathered by email and phone surveys and public profile information.
