Program Requirements

You will earn your DNP by completing 30 credits, including 15 credits dedicated to your DNP program project. All courses must be taken at Salve Regina University to obtain your advanced degree. To apply, you must have a master's degree in nursing, hold an RN license (or eligibility for RN licensure in Rhode Island) or an APRN license and certification and you must have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher at your prior institution(s). All qualified students are eligible for admission regardless of race, color, age, gender, disability, religion or national origin.
