# Master of Science in Nursing - FNP

## Program Requirements

You will earn your MSN-FNP by completing 48 credits and a minimum of 600 hours of precepted clinical work (split across three or more courses). A minimum of 30 credits must be taken at Salve Regina University to obtain your master's degree. To apply, you must have an RN license that is current and in good standing, and you must have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher. All qualified students are eligible for admission regardless of race, color, age, gender, disability, religion or national origin.
