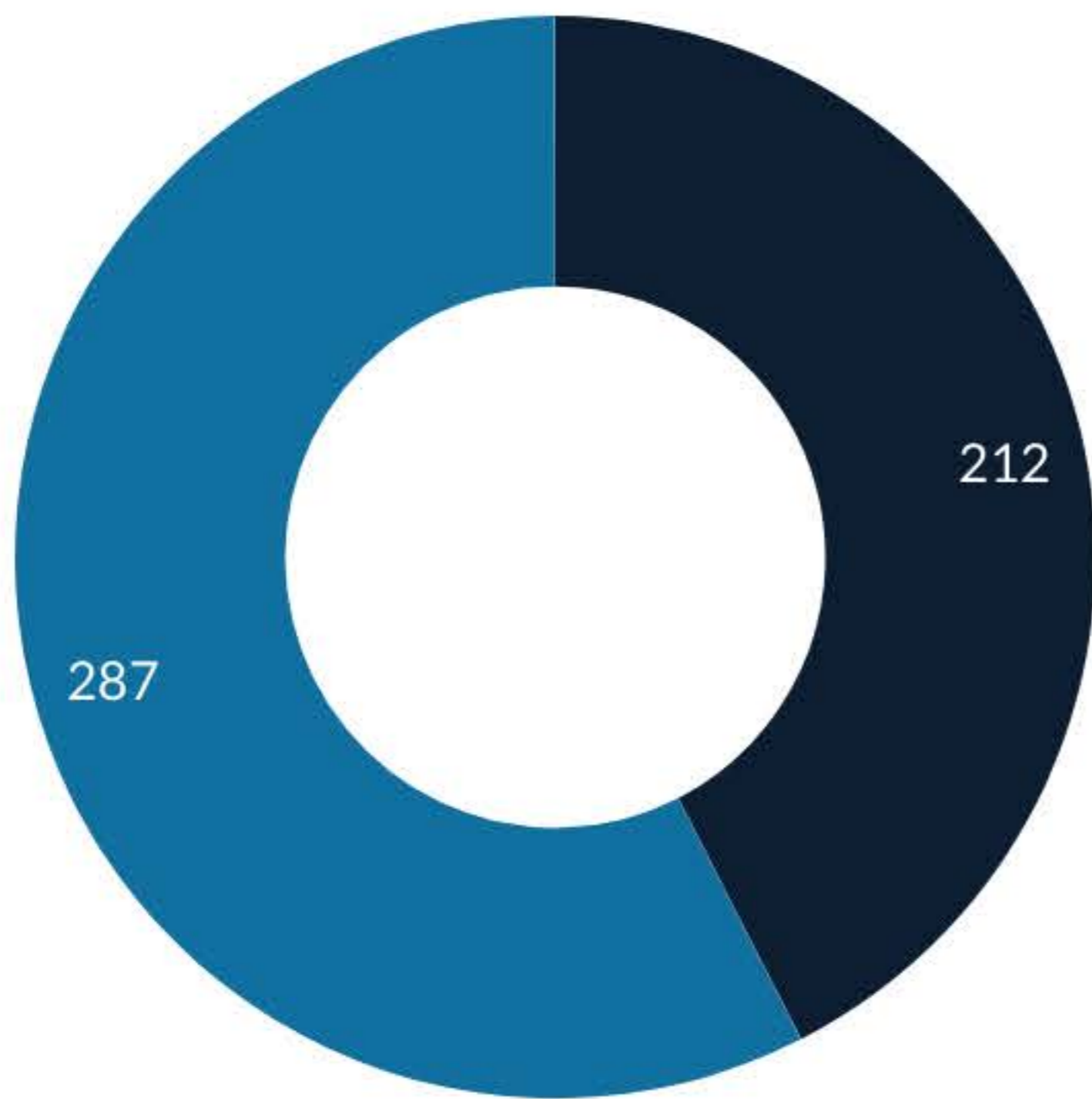

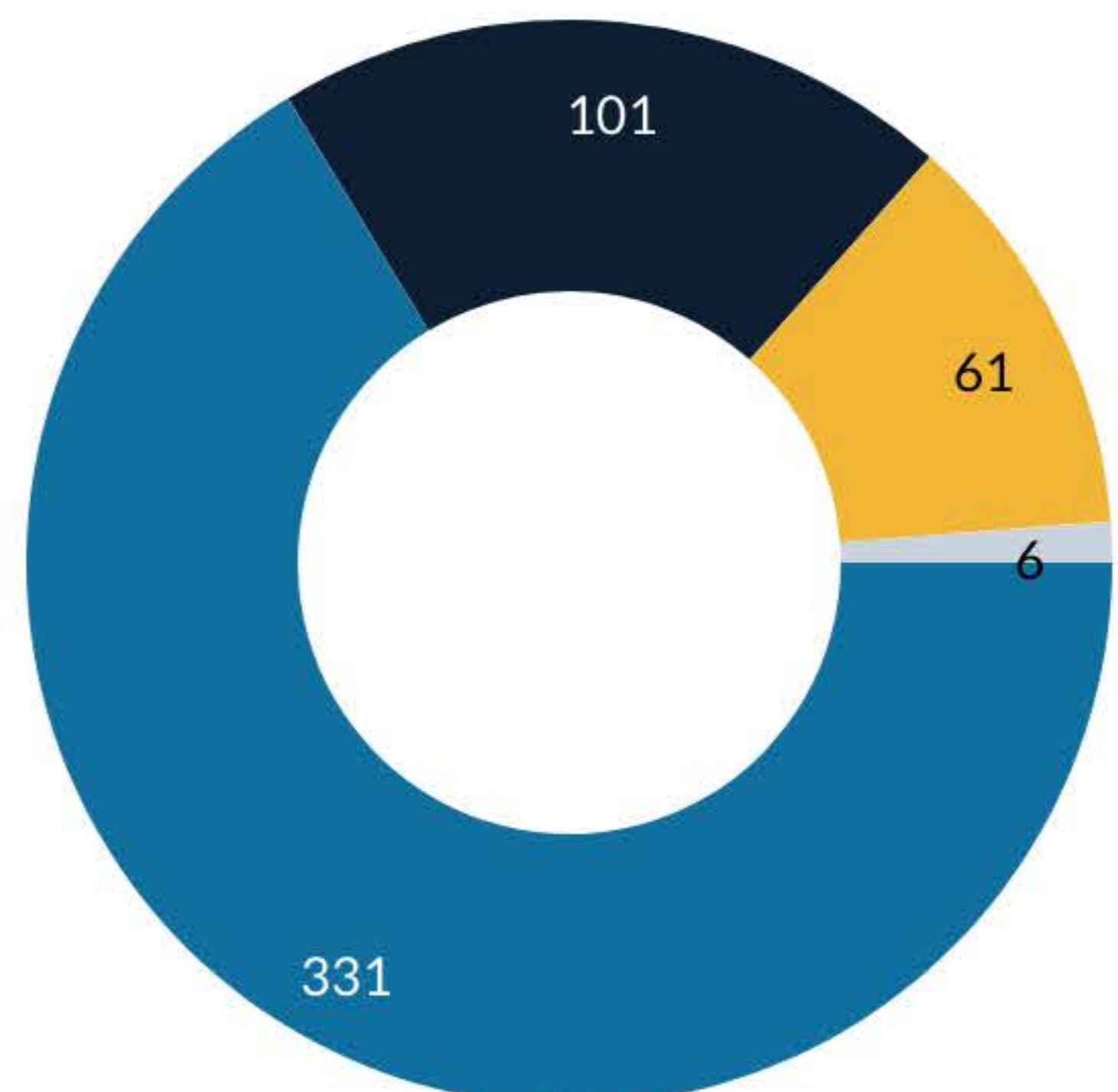

APPOINTMENTS BY SEMESTER



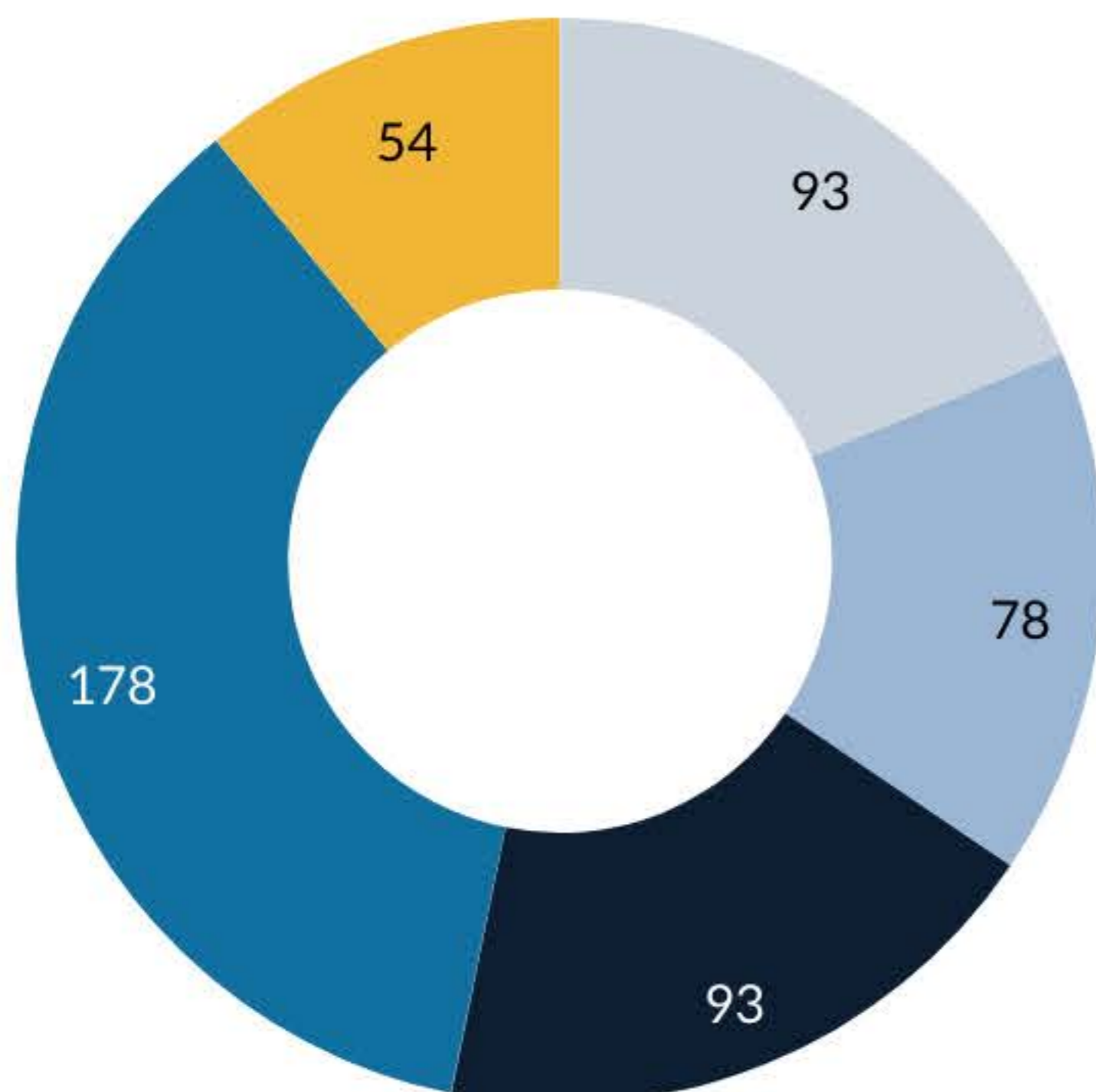

APPOINTMENTS BY MEDIUM



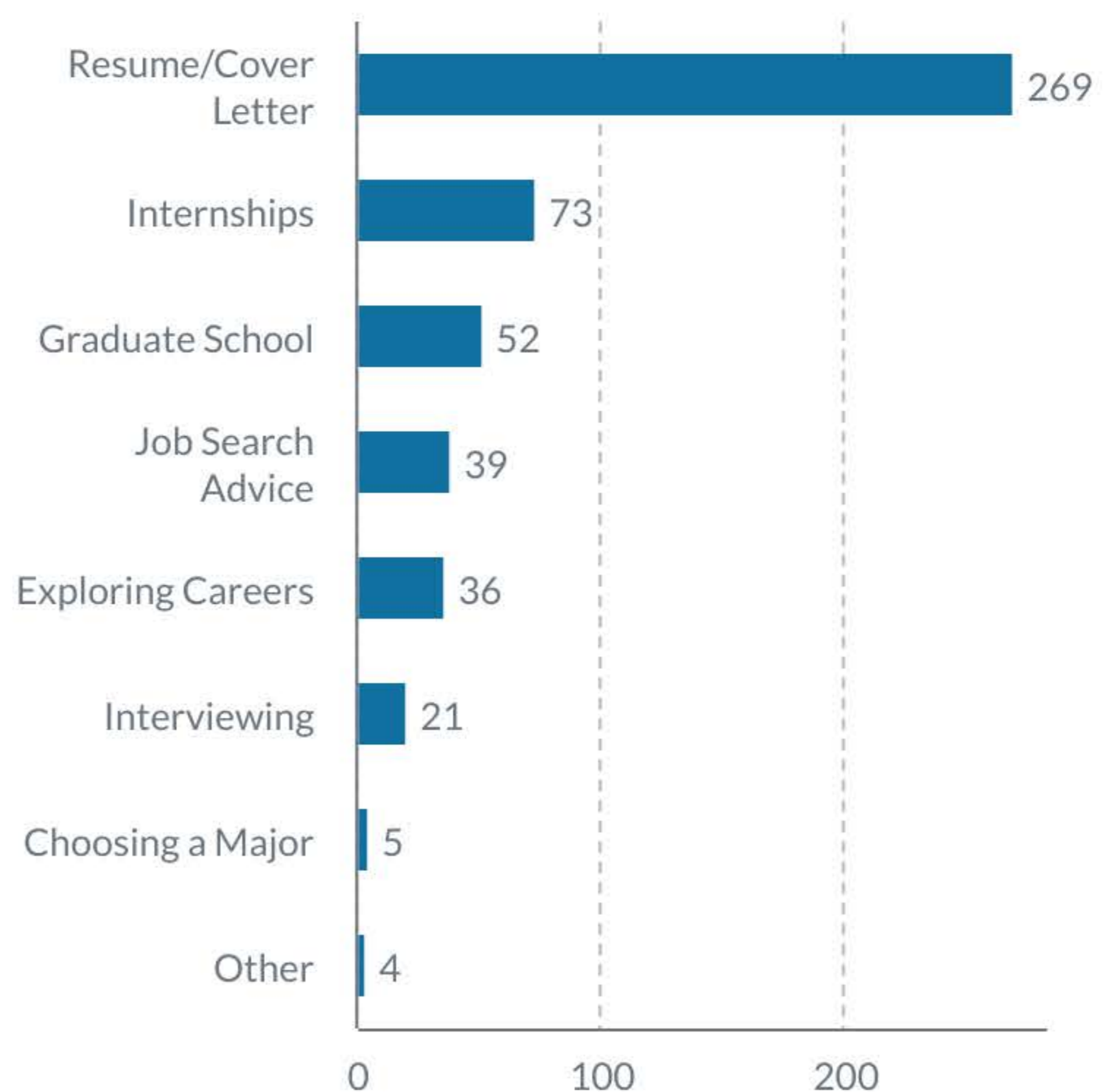

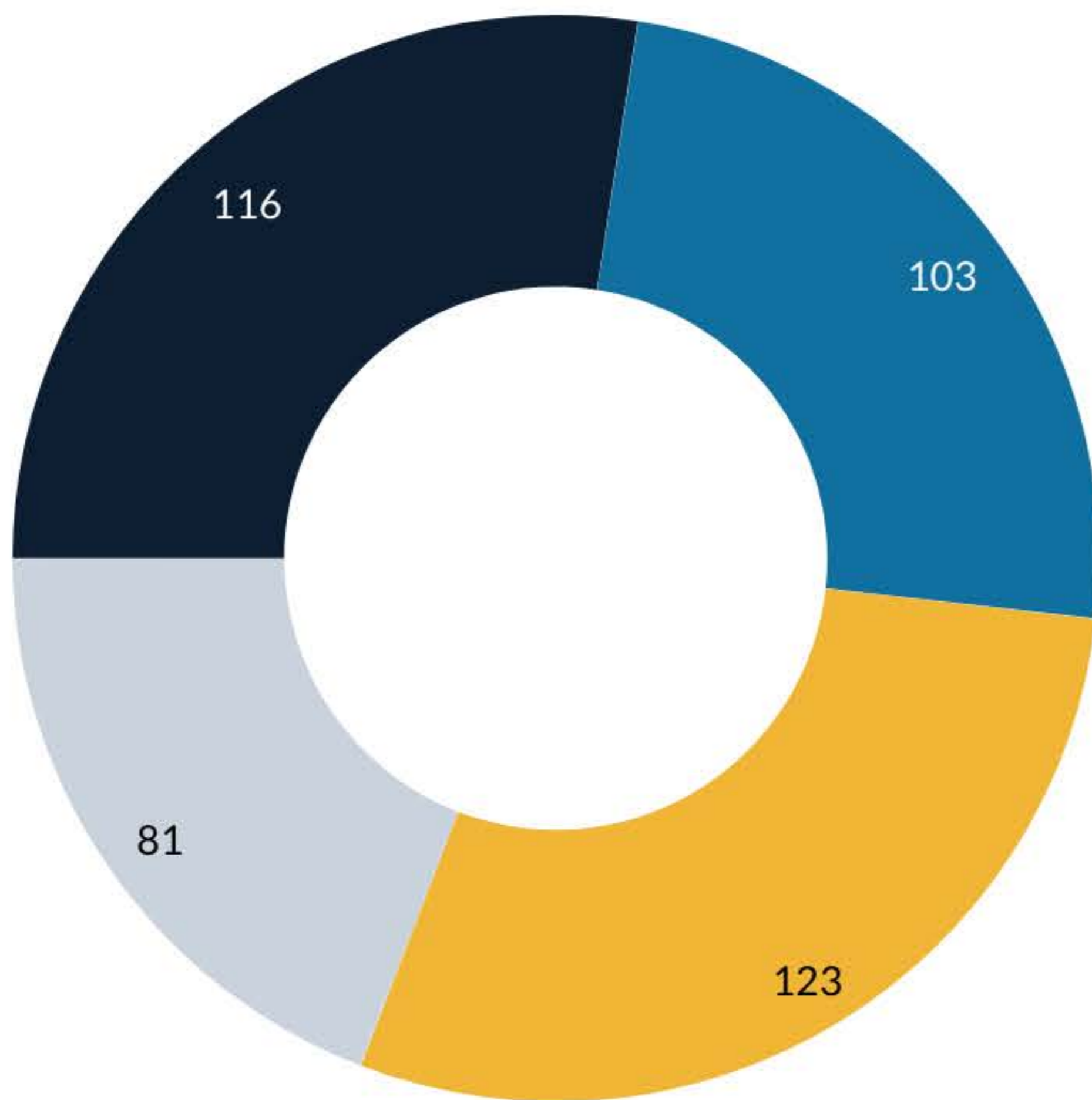
