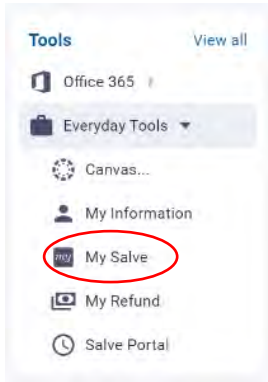
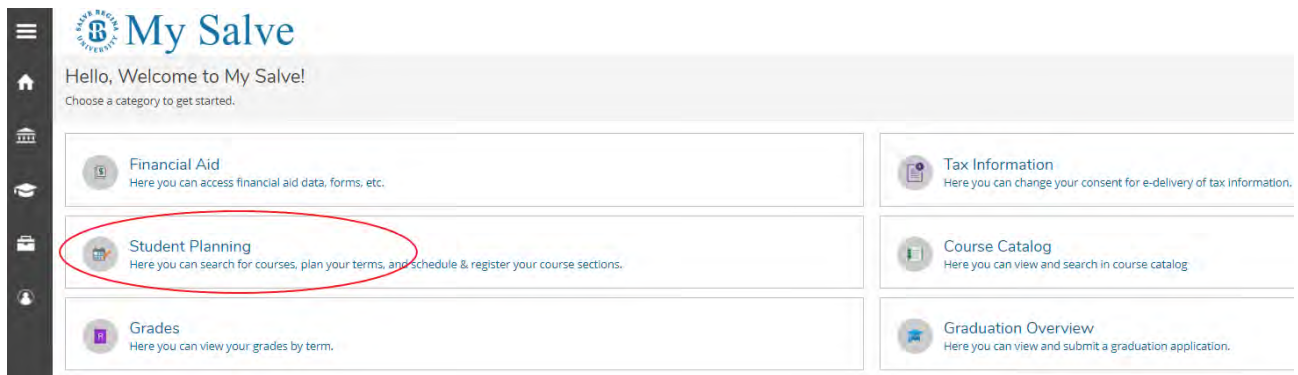


How to Register for courses through My Salve

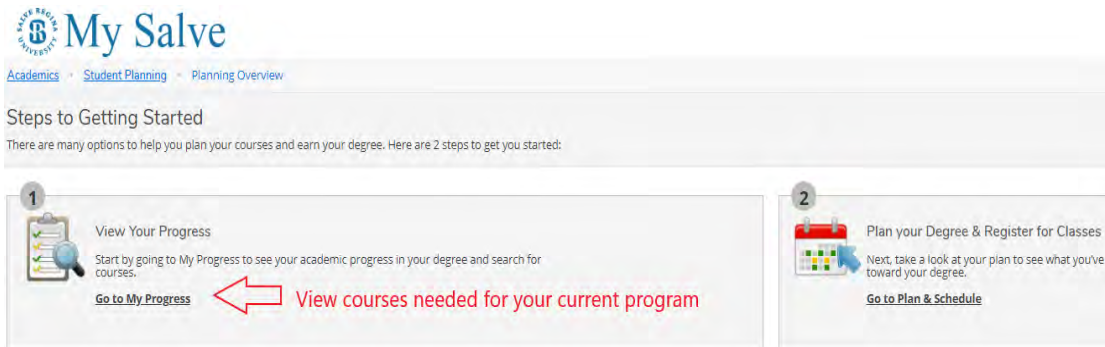


- Log into into Campus@Salve at <https://campus.salve.edu/activity>
- Locate the **Tools** bar on the left side of the page, then select **Everyday Tools**
- The link to **My Salve** will appear in the menu
- Click on **My Salve**

Additional Information: Business and Technology for Persons with Disabilities: Students will examine the impact of technology in business by researching ways technology has been implemented in business and how this affects persons with disabilities. Current practice and future trends are considered. Students will look at international and domestic issues concerning job skills involving technology in business. From this research, students in teams will design, prepare, test and implement lessons for the Learning Unlimited Program. Each student, in a small team, will prepare written unit lessons, write an abstract suitable for submission to an International Business or Education Conference that accepts student papers, and write a summary paper along with an oral presentation written aids. 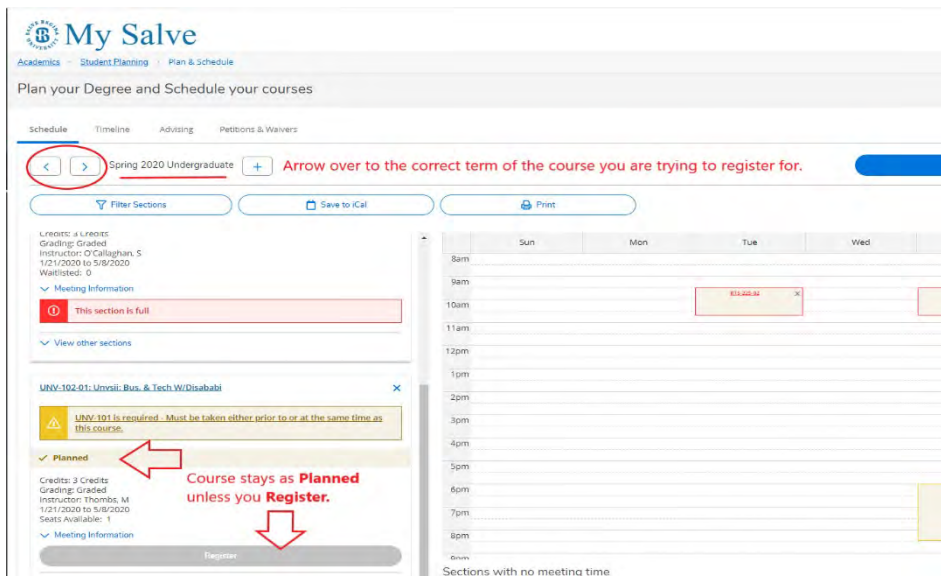
Once the section has been added to your schedule as "Planned", it is now time to register.
