## Stay Ahead in a Rapidly Changing World

Our Certificate of Graduate Studies programs are designed for professionals who want to hone or expand their skills in rapidly changing areas such as marketing, fundraising and futuring. We currently offer two certificate programs: Social Entrepreneurship or Nonprofit Management.

Pursuing a graduate certificate allows you to select four graduate-level courses that relate directly to your personal career goals. Our certificate in Social Entrepreneurship is uniquely aligned with the University's mission and explores social responsibility for people, community and the environment. The goal of our Nonprofit Management certificate is to cover the essential skill areas needed to thrive as a manager - human resources, management, marketing/fundraising, and finance. The certificate topics are applicable in both the private and public sectors.

Should you wish to continue on to a master's program, the four courses in either certificate apply toward the 12 courses needed for a master's degree in business administration (MBA) or the master's in Innovation and Strategic Management.

Certificate programs are completed entirely online, although select courses may be offered on our Newport campus. Online courses are offered in compressed, seven-week sessions. There are six online sessions per year.

# Graduate Certificates in Management

## Admissions Requirements

The Certificate of Graduate Studies (CGS) is designed for students who hold a baccalaureate or master's degree and wish to pursue graduate work to meet personal or professional goals.

## How to Get Started

Students apply using a streamlined certificate program application. There is no fee to apply. You must submit the following to be considered:

- Completed certificate program application
- Official transcripts from each previous college/university attended
- Resume

The application is accessed online at [admissions.salve.edu/apply](http://admissions.salve.edu/apply).

Each successful class completion will earn graduate credit. Should the student wish to continue on to a master's program, they should contact the Office of Graduate Admissions. Credits earned in the certificate program may be applied to the master's degree consistent with University policy.
