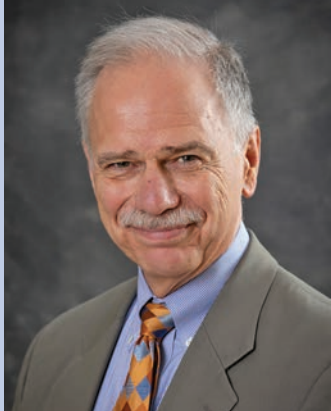

Admission Requirements

Individuals with a bachelor's degree in any undergraduate major from a regionally accredited college or university (or an equivalent degree from an accredited institution outside of the United States) are qualified to apply. Salve Regina University evaluates the total application package.

How to Apply

There is no fee to apply; materials are submitted online at salve.edu/grad. In addition to the completed application, you must submit the following:

- Completed graduate application form
- Official transcripts from all degree granting institutions attended
- Personal statement
- Two professional letters of recommendation

Objectives

Curriculum

Students must successfully complete 12 courses totaling 36 credits to earn the master's degree. The following represent the core courses in the curriculum. Depending on their experience, students may substitute additional elective courses for a core course with the graduate program director's approval.

Students must also complete two electives. Students with work experience may replace the internship with a third elective with approval of the program director.
